The Listener undertakes to maintain the cassette playing machine in good order, fair wear and tear and accidental damage excepted.

The Listener undertakes to return the periodic cassettes by post in the container provided to the Talking Newspaper within not more than seven days from the date of receipt by the Listener.

The Listener shall be at liberty to use the machine for the playing of any other cassettes and/or to make recordings.

In the event of the Listener moving permanently away from the area, or being adjudged bankrupt, or suffering for any cause or dying, then in any such case the Listener (or in the case of death, the Listener's executors or heirs) shall forthwith return the cassette playing machine, together with any cassettes to the Talking Newspaper.
